

Accented characters in French

MS Word shortcuts (also works for TextPad)

These characters are also available in the Drop-Down at the top of the screen:
Insert/Symbol

<i>To obtain:</i>	<i>press keys together then let go (ignore the + sign)</i>	<i>then type</i>
à	Ctrl + ` (that little back to front apostrophe - top left of the keyboard)	a
è, ù	Proceed as above	type the appropriate vowel (it doesn't work with consonants)
é	Ctrl + ' (apostrophe)	e
â, ê, î, ô, û	Ctrl + Shift + ^ (press the 3 keys together)	type the appropriate vowel
ç	Ctrl + , (the comma)	c
œ	Ctrl + Shift + &	o
ë, ï	Ctrl + Shift + :	type the appropriate vowel

ASCII codes for other software (American Standard Code for Information Interchange)

You can find the complete table on numerous websites, but it is usually displayed in numerical order and makes it difficult to find the right letter. Other letters are available for other languages, as well as the accented uppercase.

Each accented letter has its dedicated code. Hold the **Alt** key and type the following numbers, using the numeric pad (it doesn't work with the other set of digits, above the letter keys)
